"IMPROVEMENT OF INFORMATION AND KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER BETWEEN SCIENCE AND PRACTICE IN FISHERY SECTOR"

Ustroń - Gołysz, 15 - 16 September 2016

The workshop is organized for the producers of food from inland fishes, farmers and processors, using traditional methods of production and processing, for representatives of producer organizations of the fishery sector, representatives of universities, research institutions working for the fishery and local authorities of areas dependent on fisheries. The aim of the workshop is to analyze the current situation in the identification of innovation needs in the fishery sector, in terms of the flow of information between science and practice and to attempt to identify solutions which should improve the transfer of information and knowledge between science and practice. The introduction to the discussion and deeper analysis of the problem will be conducted of invited experts. Lectures will be conducted in Polish.
